2. Product Overview


Smart Wall Direct is a plugin installed on the operator machines to be able to maximize any camera on the XProtect Smart Wall monitors from any operator machine.

3. Installation


To install Smart Wall Direct, the installation file should be downloaded from [Systeminence portal](#). Once downloaded, you can start the installation.




On the welcome screen, click “Next”



On the next screen, check and accept the EULA



On the next screen, the installer will be checking the dependencies. If needed, the dependencies will be installed automatically.



On the next screen, provide the XProtect Management Server address, login type and username and password.

The supported login types are:

- Windows authentication (current user): This type of windows authentication is used to login using the current logged in user.
- Windows authentication: This type of authentication uses a windows login but different than the already logged in user.
- Basic user: This type of authentication uses a user created in Milestone

Once the following credentials are provided, click save. The installer will check the connection to the XProtect Management Server and in case it is successful, the installation will proceed, otherwise the installation will not proceed and an error message will be displayed.



In case the demo license has expired, an error message will appear when the Smart Wall Direct icon will be clicked.
